ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAX FOR THE YEAR 2020 SETTING SPECIFIC TAX RATES, APPLICABLE TO ALL REAL, PERSONAL, AND MIXED PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE CAMERON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, SETTING DUE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND INTEREST ON DELINQUENT TAXES.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Cameron Independent School District of Cameron, Milam County, Texas:

(1) That an ad valorem tax rate of \$1.28 per \$100.00 cash valuation and assessment ratio of 100% market value, as said values are fixed by the Board of Review, and the same is hereby levied for the year 2020 on all real property, personal property, and mixed property located and situated within the confines and boundaries of Cameron Independent School District as of January 1 of this tax year.


(2) That the above specified ad valorem tax rate be distributed as follows:

- (a) \$0.9614 rate for local maintenance fund
- (b) \$0.3186 rate for debt service, bonded indebtedness, and interest and sinking fund

PASSED AND APPROVED and effective this 31st day of August, A.D. 2020.
