

- 6) The Yoe Band Program and Mr. Steven Moss with his assistants were recognized for their success this Fall. The Band received Straight 1's at the UIL Marching Contest. They were one of three schools to receive this rating. The high school had nine members selected to the All-Region Band with three advancing to the Area Round. The junior high auditioned forty-five members with twenty-one members named to the All-Region Band. This was the most named of any school in the Region.
 - 7) The Cameron ISD will host the UIL Regional Concert and Sight Reading Contest this Spring for area 3A schools. Over twenty schools will compete in the one day competition among them the Yoe High Band. A tape of the Band will be produced for selection as a State Honor Band in Texas.
 - 8) A Facility Report was provided detailing the progress of the ongoing projects. The Lift Station at the Athletic Complex is in progress along with the different classroom projects.
