The CISD Board of Trustees met on November 9, 2009 in regular session.

The Cameron ISD is proud to announce its recognition in receiving the Texas Education Agency's "Gold Performance Awards". Mr. Rodney Fausett stated, "TEA issues Gold Performance acknowledgements to campuses and districts which have exceeded standards set at the highest levels in areas not addressed in the basic accountability system. Our students and staff are to be commended for their performance. I am very proud of them." This year CISD received 9 performance awards in the following areas:
