The CISD Board of Trustees met on September 14, 2009 in regular session.

The Cameron ISD in coordination with the Milam County Health Department will provide flu shots “free of charge” to all employees who desire this vaccine. Superintendent Rodney Fausett recommended this employee benefit for the second year in a row as “support of the staff as a health benefit.” The cost to the district if each employee gets the vaccine will be \$4,760, or \$20 dollars per employee. Also, student vaccines will be “free” to all students. Employee vaccinations will be held on September 16<sup>th</sup>. Information on the H1N1 has not been made available, but will be provided when received by the district.

Coach Linda Richter received Special Recognition at the meeting. Coach Richter was recently recognized by the Texas Girls Coaches Association for her achievements in Track & Field. Coach Richter received a plaque from Superintendent Fausett in acknowledgement of the CISD.

The board approved a Resolution and Adjunct Faculty Agreement with the Milam County 4-H organization. This agreement allows 4-Hers to be considered “in attendance” during 4-H events supervised by AgriLife Extension Service employees.
