OVERVIEW

A person may be nominated in one of the following categories:

1. Student Alumni
2. Retired Staff
3. Community Member

The individual must be recognized as a positive role model, a person of character and uncommon dedication, who goes beyond the call of duty to assist students, parents, staff and/or the community in which they reside, and/or has brought honor to the Cameron Independent School District or the community of Cameron.

STUDENT ALUMNI

1. Must have graduated from Cameron Independent School District fifteen (15) or more years ago.
2. Must have made significant contributions to the community, state, nation or world through good works or charitable beneficence.
3. Must have achieved outstanding success in business, athletics, academics, education, the arts, humanitarian efforts, community service or other endeavors.
4. Must be a role model that current and future generations of Cameron Independent School District students can emulate.

RETIRED STAFF

1. Must be someone who has retired or not been employed by the Cameron Independent School District for five (5) or more years prior to nomination and whose efforts have contributed significantly to the district.
2. Must have taught or been an administrator in the Cameron Independent School District for fifteen (15) or more years. (The award may be given posthumously.)

3. Must have made significant contributions or achievements that benefited the Cameron Independent School District, staff, and/or students.
4. Must have exhibited leadership, character and/or service that inspires others.

COMMUNITY MEMBERS

1. Individuals who may or may not have been a graduate of the Cameron Independent School District, but who have made a significant contribution, which helped make the Cameron Independent School District a better place for children.
2. Must be a patron/benefactor/leader that has contributed to the Cameron Independent School District or the community in an exemplary manner. (The award may be given posthumously.)
3. Must demonstrate leadership, character, service, and be a positive role model for community members and Cameron ISD students to emulate.
